Good afternoon, welcome to the Bronx area GSR meeting. We had an admin body meeting on October 21st

We had a meeting on Thursday October 24th to discuss the upcoming virtual learning day. The date is now February 22, from 12pm-4pm. We will be creating a flyer and a subcommittee grid for presentations. All subcommittees should be prepared with a prestaton and questions and Answers.

We are having a lot of member inquiries about the anonymity of NA. A newcomer or a sick and suffering addict may be discouraged from seeking recovery he /she sees posted photographs or full names identifying members. As members we should use our literature as a guide to making decision that affect the groups and NA as a whole.

Anonymity is essential in preserving the stability of our fellowship, making personal recovery possible

Photos, Videos, and Social Media – We recognize that it is a common practice for members to take photos and videos at NA events and post them on social networks. We do not believe this to be in conflict with our traditions so long as they are for the enjoyment of members and are not made available to the general public. Please be considerate of our guiding principles and the anonymity of others as you share your photos and videos from this NA event. For more information, please see the service pamphlet Social Media and Our Guiding Principles.

Eleventh Tradition calls on each of us as individual members to be mindful of the public visibility of our online interactions. Some members are not very concerned about sharing personal information in a very open and accessible manner, but our Eleventh

Tradition reminds us that when it comes to membership in NA, the credibility of our program of recovery can be greatly affected by the actions of individual NA members.

Another unintended consequence of our online activity is that addicts who have not yet found recovery may find NA unattractive if they think that joining NA could mean having NA information posted on their social networking profiles for friends and family to see.

IP#15. We do not give our last names nor appear in the media as members of Narcotics Anonymous. As part of our spiritual program of recovery, we avoid self-promotion in favor of a more humble style of service. In our experience, members who become “media stars” in relationship to their membership in NA run the risk of placing the spiritual foundation of their recovery in jeopardy as well as giving the public an inaccurate perspective of recovery in NA.

We can also go to Tradition 11, Tradition 5, and our 3rd Tradition in it works how and why.

This is for information purposes and to guide you to the literature, not to have a Bronx area platform long discussion about something that has been written long before we arrived.

Betty-Ann read the Tradition – Richie H. shared on the tradition, Bernadette and Hank shared on the tradition.


