

May 3, 2025

Underground Miracles reopened at 2090 East 180th Street and Honeywell Avenue on Monday, April 7, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. The facility can accommodate 35-40 people.

PR will host a hybrid Learning Day at 1870 Crotona Avenue on Saturday, June 14, from 1:00 to 5:00 p.m.

PR participated in the Area learning day on April 19.

We attended the Northeast Zonal Forum PR workshop on April 25-27, 2025, in Frazer, PA, at the Northeastern States Service Symposium (NESSNA 3).

Anna and I returned in time to attend the PR committee meeting on April 27.

We will also have a table opportunity to give out literature at the Hunts Point library on Monday, June 16, from 12 noon to 2 pm. We have also been blessed with the opportunity to have our Basic Text placed in all 35 Public Libraries (NYPLs) in the Bronx.

The PR committee will request \$490.00 to purchase the 35 basic texts to be placed in the libraries.
